



BB03 Pleasant Hill, Louisiana - April 9, 1864 (Scenario Brian Bradford)

Historical Overview

The Battle of Pleasant Hill was fought on April 9, 1864, during the Red River Campaign of the American Civil War, near Pleasant Hill, Louisiana, between Union forces led by Maj. Gen. Nathaniel P. Banks and Confederate forces, led by Maj. Gen. Richard

The stage is set, the battle lines are drawn, and you are in command. The rest is history.

Staffing Notes

Union: Nathaniel P. Banks 3 Command cards

Confederate: Richard Taylor

4 Command cards You move first

Victory Conditions:

6 VP

Special Rules:

Pleasant Hill is worth 1 flag towards victory for the Confederate side when occupied by any Confed unit OR if all hexes of the town and hill are clear of Union forces. The Confederate starts with 1 Victory Flag because of this rule.

W BATTLE CRY

Confederate reinforcements: Reinforcements arrive on Turn 2 as indicated on the map.
